Total renovation of Södermalm's most famous silhouette

The Laurin house is a building situated on Mariaberget in Stockholm. Vafrid Karlsson designed it in 1891. Between 2010 and 2012 a renovation was undertaken of the exterior including all roofs, facades and balconies. Our role as architects was to coordinate consultants for roofing, masonry, plaster, electricity, pipes and ventilation.

The building is classed as cultural heritage resulting in strict requirements of awareness in relation to visual aspects when making additions to the building during the renovation. Full renovations of the hallways, lighting and courtyard were also made.
