Lidköping City Library relocated in January 2013. pS Arkitektur has made the interior design for the main room on street level, including reception, formed like two stylized trees, sections for children and youngsters, exhibition wall and more.

The experience of the library is like walking through a fairytale story of age crossing thematic zones. Here you can find a meadow, a crafts corner, a "climbing hill" which is also a sitting bench, a book tunnel with seating in the bookshelves and fiber optic "stars" in the ceiling, a hang-out and group space for youngsters and custom made seating for the chess club.

The newspaper and magazine section is situated by the glazed, double height facade facing the pedestrian street, close to the library café. Here one can also find touchdown places for individual work and group meetings.
