The Mountain Cabin is available in two sizes, Little Skarven and Great Skarven. They are designed is derived from the local climate and design tradition of Härjedalen. The Mountain cabin looks from the outside like a reduced barn-architecture.

The office has produced 10 ski cabins located in Härjedalen. They are built with prefabricated elements from Norrlands Trähus. Internal fittings such as kitchens, bathrooms and a sauna by Fjällmark Bygg.

The main space is clad on ceilings in walls by plywood, that gives a warm colour contrasting to the white snow. The furniture consists of modern classics like Eames chairs and lights by Tom Dixon. The bathroom walls and floor are clad with local stone slabs, skiffer, with under floor heating. Building materials and installations are of very high quality and are chosen with great care to achieve long life, low energy and the right "feeling".
